WHY DARJEELING WORKS FOR PETS

Darjeeling brings together tea gardens, mountain views, heritage neighbourhoods and leisurely walks — making it an exciting hill holiday to experience with your pet.

It is best suited to pets who are comfortable around cooler weather, winding roads and busier town environments.

Unlike a purely secluded mountain retreat, Darjeeling gives you the opportunity to explore together while still having plenty of quiet spaces to retreat to.

GETTING THERE WITH YOUR PET

Suggested Route:

Siliguri Kurseong Darjeeling

The journey takes you gradually into the hills, with winding roads and beautiful views along the way.

Traffic can become moderate to busy, particularly around popular areas and during peak travel periods.

Our suggestion:

Take a break around Kurseong for refreshments, water and a short walk before continuing towards Darjeeling.

For pets prone to motion sickness, keep the final mountain drive slow and comfortable, with appropriate breaks.

PET NOTES

- Darjeeling is best suited to pets who are comfortable with hill roads, cooler temperatures and moderate crowds.
- The mountain roads are winding, so pets prone to motion sickness may need extra care.
- Keep your pet leashed around viewpoints, town areas, roads and public spaces.
- Tea garden walks and mountain trails can include uneven or slippery sections, especially after rain.
- Mall Road and other popular town areas can become busy. Choose quieter hours for more comfortable walks.
- Some attractions and indoor establishments may not permit pets. Always check before entering.
- Carry a warm layer for your pet, particularly during early mornings and evenings.
- Weather can change quickly in the hills, so carrying rain protection is advisable.
- Keep drinking water available during walks and sightseeing.
- Avoid allowing your pet to wander freely in tea gardens, forests or unfamiliar areas.
- Carry your pet's regular food, water bowl, leash, waste bags, bedding, towel, basic first-aid supplies and any regular medication.

SUGGESTED PET-PACED ITINERARY

DAY 1 | SILIGURI DARJEELING

Drive from Siliguri towards Darjeeling via Kurseong.

Take a comfortable break along the way and continue towards the hills.

Check into your stay and allow your pet time to settle in.

Keep the evening relaxed with a gentle walk around the property or nearby quieter streets.

Arrive. Breathe in the mountain air. Slow down.

DAY 2 | BATASIA LOOP & TEA GARDENS

Start the morning with a visit to the Batasia Loop surroundings.

Continue towards the tea gardens and enjoy a leisurely walk where permitted.

Return to the property for a relaxed afternoon.

In the evening, explore a quieter section of town or take a leisurely walk around the neighbourhood.

DAY 3 | TAKDAH & THE QUIET HILLS

Take a scenic drive towards Takdah, one of the quieter corners around Darjeeling.

Explore the surrounding landscapes and scenic spots at an easy pace.

Allow plenty of time for short walks, photographs and simply enjoying the mountain scenery.

Return to Darjeeling for a relaxed final evening.

Today, trade the crowds for the quieter side of the hills.

DAY 4 | DARJEELING DEPARTURE

Enjoy breakfast and one final morning walk.

Check out and begin your onward journey.

If time permits, take one last scenic stop before descending towards Siliguri.
